

Parking in Kennett Square



Street Meters

Street meters are enforced 9am until 5pm Monday through Saturday, except federal holidays. Coming in for dinner after 5pm? No need to feed the meter. Grabbing coffee before 9am, no need to pay the meter until 9am. Parking meters are free on Sunday.

Parking Garage

Our well-lit and convenient parking garage located on East Linden Street has ground floor metered parking and the rest is permit. Meter and permit enforcement happens Monday through Friday 9am to 5pm. The parking garage is free in all areas after 5pm on weekdays and all weekend long.

Surface Lots

Surface lots are made up of a combo of permit spaces and metered spaces. Enforcement of surface lots 9-5pm Monday through Friday (permit and meter spaces) These surface lots provide free parking after 5pm and all weekend long (Saturday & Sunday).

Paying for Parking in Kennett Square

- Most meters are limited to 3 hour parking. There are a few 15 minute and 6 hour parking meters located on various streets.
- The cost of the meter is 25 cents for 20 minutes. All meters accept quarters, dimes, nickels and tokens.
- Save on parking by using Tokens and Smart Cards!

Tokens: 1 Token for 20 minutes (sold only in bags of 100 for \$20.00, savings of 5 Cents per 20 minutes)

Smart Cards: User friendly—\$16.00 for over 26 Hours of parking (also available in larger denominations)

Tokens and Smart Cards can be purchased at the Borough Hall, 120 Marshall Street



- **Use the Passport Parking Mobile Parking App.**—free to download from the iPhone App Store and Android Google Play. Users can also manage their parking online at **ppprk.com**. Once users download the app they will be asked to create an account which includes a verification process through phone or email and the creation of a pin number. To begin the parking payment process a user will be prompted to enter a zone number (found on meters). The user then enters a debit/credit card and the parked vehicle's license plate number.
